# Conclusions from the Bible

- The Bible unequivocally condemns homosexual practice.
- It is not a part of God's created order
- Marriage comes from God and is consecrated by God. He will not consecrate a relationship based on man's unregenerate interpretation of original sin as part of man's created being.
- In other words, man's insistence that his original, inherent sinfulness is morally correct simply adds more sin to the list.

- 4. You tell a co-worker that you believe God condemns homosexual practice. The next day your boss calls you into his office and tells you that you are creating a hostile work environment. How do you respond?
